

Criminal Justice Instructor

**POSITION
DESCRIPTION:**

The position is a standard nine-month appointment with potential summer assignments beginning August 2019. The primary responsibility of this position is to provide quality instruction in a variety of criminal justice courses. Additional responsibilities include, but are not limited to assessment of institution/program/course learning objectives, academic advisement of students; coordination of the Criminal Justice program; curriculum review and revision; committee assignment and participation; recruitment, retention, and mentoring activities; and community involvement. This position reports to the Vice President of Workforce Development.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice or Criminology is required. Master's degree in Criminal Justice, Criminology, or in a closely related discipline is preferred. Five years of experience in law enforcement or corrections is highly preferred. Experience in college teaching is also preferred. The successful candidate must possess a current knowledge and understanding of developments in the field of Criminal Justice; exhibit initiative; be flexible to teach day, evening, online and secondary classes; be able to communicate effectively in oral and written form; be willing to work closely with employers and must reside in the service area.
