
Early Retirement Deadline

A Phishing email is an attack that attempts to steal your money, or your identity, by getting you to reveal personal information -- such as credit card numbers, bank information, or passwords. Never respond to an email or open any attachments that look suspicious. You will never receive an email from human resources or payroll asking you to verify information such as social security numbers, or verifying/changing your direct deposit. Always report phishing emails or scams to Tach Butler at tbutler@smail.anc.edu. When in doubt, always reach out to HR, Payroll, MITS or the ANC person directly to verify that the email is not a scam.
