*2023-24 Cost of Attendance*

The Higher Education Act (Section 472) requires schools to publish a student’s anticipated Cost of Attendance. The Cost of Attendance (COA) is the cornerstone of establishing a student’s financial need, as it sets a limit on the total aid that a student may receive. The COA for a student is an estimate of that student’s educational expenses for the period of enrollment fall/spring. Cost of Attendance figures are not owed directly to the college but are intended to help students understand the overall costs they can anticipate during their enrollment. The COA includes 5 components as outlined below and are determined by reviewing ANC student’s typical cost expenditures.
