# ANC Faculty & Staff Present at Arkansas Community Colleges Conference

Several ANC Faculty and Staff members made presentations at the Arkansas Community Colleges Conference in Little Rock. Ken Barton, Dr. Jillian Hartley, Dustin Kemper, Lance Morris, and Tonya Pankey presented "Creating and Implementing Multimodal Instruction." Their presentation detailed the efforts of Arkansas Northeastern College to create and implement multimodal courses over the past year. The well-attended presentation covered topics related to faculty compensation, and the methods used to determine how to utilize best practices from both face-to-face and online courses into one multimodal format that allows students to attend class in person, from a remote location, or asynchronously with instructional videos.





### **ANC Professor Presents at NISOD**

Lance Morris, ANC Professor of Biology & Life Sciences, recently presented at the NISOD national conference. Morris discussed the multimodal delivery system in a presentation titled, "General Biology Lab in the Multimodal Format." In summary, the Multimodal delivery allows students to attend a lab in person or via Zoom. Online students use an instructor-created lab kit along with student-provided supplies to complete the exact same labs as students attending in person. Students watch the initial presentation via Zoom (or the recorded presentation) and submit the same lab report as students attending the lab in person. Learning outcomes can be modified to achieve what is needed for students and the instructor.


