Beat the Heat Safety Precautions

Heat is one of the leading weather-related killers in the United States. Extreme heat or heat waves occur when the temperature reaches extremely high levels. Heat related illnesses, like heat exhaustion or heat stroke, happen when the body is not able to properly cool itself. While the body normally cools itself by sweating during extreme heat, this might not be enough. In these cases, a person's body temperature rises faster than it can cool down.

This can cause damage to the brain and other vital organs.

The best advice is to drink plenty of fluids, stay out of the sun, and in an air-conditioned place. If you work or spend time outside, take extra precautions, such as frequent rest breaks in shaded or air-conditioned locations. Also wear clothing that is light weight and loose fitting. If possible, reschedule strenuous activities for the early morning or evening, when cooler temperatures prevail. Car interiors can reach deadly temperatures in a matter of minutes during hot or warm weather. It is NEVER safe to leave a child, disabled person or pet unattended in vehicles. An estimated 38 children die each year from vehicular heatstroke. Check on friends, family, and neighbors. Always provide water to your pet, whether inside or out. If your pet is outside, make sure they have plenty of shade and access to plenty of cool water. Anyone overcome by heat should be moved to a cool and shaded location.


