Multiple Solutions Group Activities

The Solutions Group's Industrial Technologies instructor, Rob Semmel, trained seven individuals from Plum Point Energy (NRG) in basic hydraulics. The training was conducted over a 10-week period at ANC's Center for Allied Technologies.

ANC Solutions Group Link I

The Solutions Group recently trained the Mississippi County EOC in basic electricity and plumbing. This training included instruction about how electricity works in commercial and industrial settings. It included hands-on electrical skills improvement and was designed to train maintenance technicians and other non-electrical personnel working in industrial plants and commercial buildings.

The Solutions Group's Industrial Technologies instructor, Rob Semmel, customized and delivered a basic hydraulics and mechanical measurements training for group operators from Big River Steel. There were two sections of basic hydraulics (16 hours for each section), and two sections of mechanical measurements (8 hours).

Career Pathways Chosen to Pilot Program

Career Pathways at Arkansas Northeastern College has recently been selected to pilot the TANF CAREERConnect subsidized employment program. Participants must be receiving Transitional Employment Assistance (TEA) benefits. The TEA program helps economically challenged families with children under the age of 18 become more responsible for the support of their families. Representatives from the local and state Department of Workforce Services were on hand to discuss the program with representatives from Arkansas Northeastern College. The program allows DWS to reimburse employers up to 100% of a participant wages for the first month and up to 50% of the employee's second-sixth months' wages. Prior to employment, Career Pathways at ANC will provide any necessary training.






ANC Hosts Skills Days 2019

Ray did a bit of traveling this summer! He traveled throughout the U.S. and crossed over into Canada. He also got to visit the Emmys.


