Public's Choice: "6-18-18" by Isaiah Klein

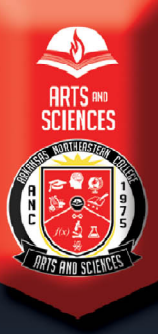

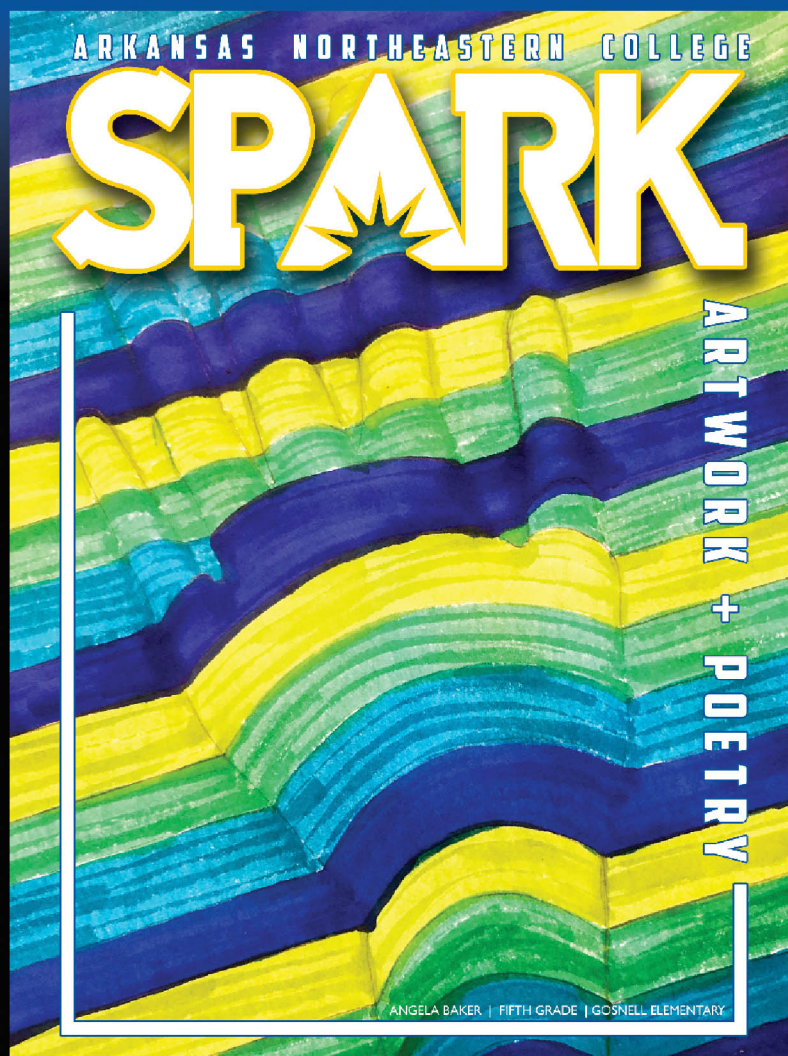


Spark Magazine Launched!

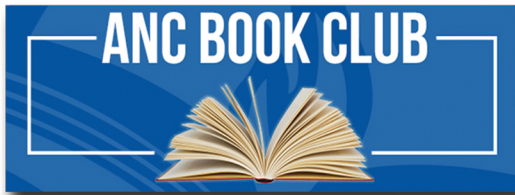
