## ANC Professor Presents at ICOFOM Symposium

Dr. Jillian Hartley, Professor of History, presented a paper at the ICOFOM International Committee for Museology's online symposium, Defining The Museum of the 21st Century: Evolving Multiculturalism in Museums in the United States on September 14. Hosted by Southern New Hampshire University, the purpose of the symposium was to assist in the creation of a definition for museums in the United States.

Hartley's contribution, "Commemorating the Civil War in Border States: The Case of John Hunt Morgan," examines how the removal of commemorative markers and efforts to interpret them for the public has the potential to enhance the educational aspects of ICOM's definition in regard to the U.S. experiential perspective of museums and heritage in the twenty-first century. 
