

Criminal Justice - Certificate of Proficiency

The certificate of proficiency in Criminal Justice is designed to give students knowledge of law enforcement concepts and practices within a non-traditional time frame. It covers the criminal justice system, juvenile law, criminal law, corrections and investigation. This certificate is designed to help individuals interested in law enforcement or corrections find entry-level employment. All courses in the Criminal Justice Certificate of Proficiency may be applied toward the Associate of Applied Science degree in Criminal Justice. Students must earn a "C" or above in each required course in order to receive a certificate of proficiency from ANC.
