If you answered “Yes” to any of these questions, or you have fever, we ask that you leave campus until you are fever free for 72 hours, or until 7 days since you had symptoms, or until a quarantine period of 14 days has elapsed in the case of contact, diagnosis, or travel.

If you answered “No” to all questions, current recommendations for disinfection and social distancing are **mandatory**. You may be asked to leave if you do not follow these restrictions. These include:

1. Wash your hands thoroughly following CDC guidelines.
2. Remain at least 6 feet away from other persons at all times.
3. Stay in the area you are approved to be in. Do not go to other buildings, offices, or areas. Do not wander around campus.
4. Groups of 10 or fewer only. Fewer is preferable.
5. Avoid common areas such as bathrooms, vending areas, or other areas that multiple people access.
6. Refrain from using vending machines.

If a building supervisor asks you to leave an ANC facility, please be understanding, and leave the building immediately.
